OVERVIEW OF THE DEBATE PROCEDURE: →

REMEMBER: 5 GROUP pts will be awarded for this assignment based on you being PRESENT in class for the DEBATE on Dec 5 th!!!

THE I-6 DEBATE QUESTION:

**Should the United States
take aggressive and
immediate action to slow
global warming?**

**(e.g. sign the International
Climate Treaty, reduce or tax
GHG emissions, etc. etc.)**

HOW THE DEBATE WILL WORK:

1) You'll get in your Groups, sitting -- FACE to FACE

2) Dress as your ROLE or put on a "ROLE LABEL" (in folder) so your roles are visible to others in the Group.

3) **THE DEBATE:** The debate begins by going around the group with EACH STUDENT READING HIS or HER prepared 1-minute OPENING STATEMENT:

" YES, the United States should take aggressive and immediate action to slow global warming. . ." or

"NO the United States should NOT take aggressive and immediate action to slow global warming. . . "

. . . with a brief explanation of WHY OR WHY NOT.

After everyone has made an opening statement, the floor is open for anyone to speak up in your group

- 4) **GENERAL OPEN DEBATE** (~15 minutes)--
- 5) **TIME CALLED**, tally of "YES" or "NO" votes (based on **ROLES**) within your group to get your group's overall vote.
- 6) You may then step out of your role and **debate /discuss** what YOU THINK!
- 7) **EVERYONE SIGNS** the "**DEBATE PARTICIPATION FORM**" to get your **5 pts.**
- 8) Each group votes on "**best costume for a role**" within your group – that student wins a mini-prize!
- 9) **LASTLY**, WE'LL TAKE **A POST-DEBATE VOTE** of you **OWN** opinion and the results will be tallied.
